Login to Look4 using your library card number (the 4-digit number on your library card).

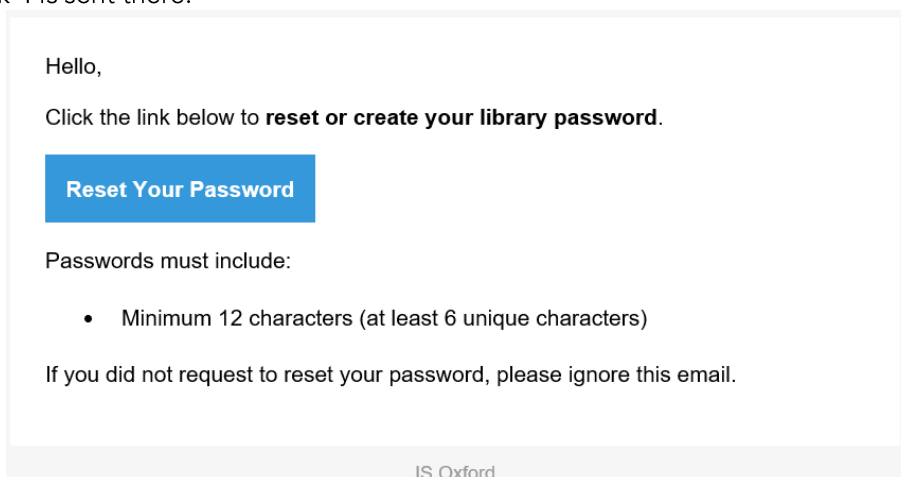

Enter your Reader code in the box below and a password reset link will be sent to your e-mail address

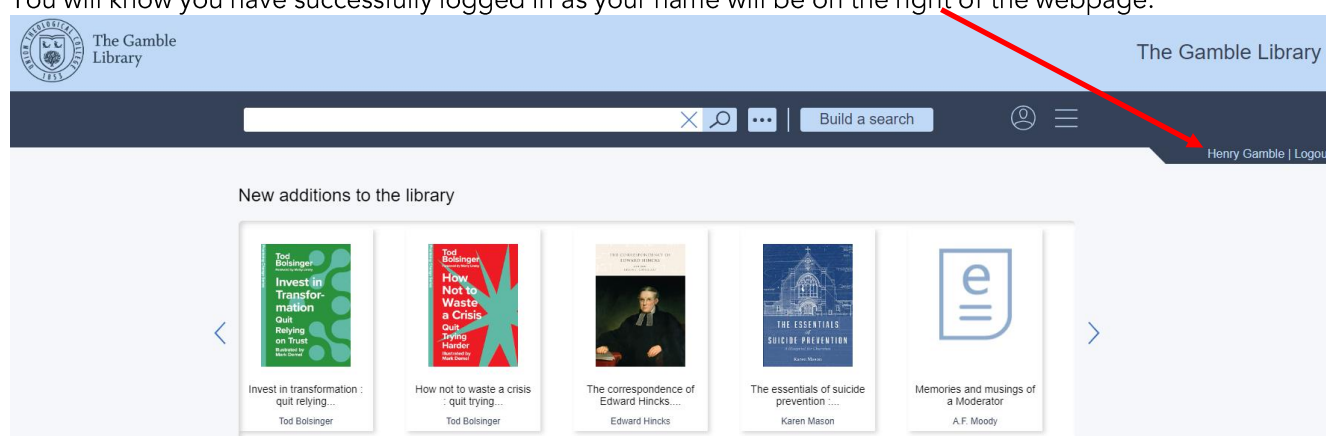

You will receive an email with a reset password link in it. It will be sent to the email address you have given library staff so make sure your contact details are up-to-date. Please check your junkmail folder in case the email from Look 4 is sent there.



Once you click the 'Reset Your Password' link and create and confirm your new password, you will be able to return to 'Login' on the right of the screen and type in your reader code and password. You will know you have successfully logged in as your name will be on the right of the webpage.





Click on your name. This should bring up your loans, and their due dates. If any are overdue, they will be in red.
